

BSC - 1020 (C) HUMAN BIOLOGY (3 Theory, 1 hour laboratory)

The study of the structure and function of the cells and tissues, and the human body as a whole. Includes the integumentary, skeletal, muscular, circulatory, and respiratory systems. The Laboratory will be used for the macroscopic and microscopic study of the structures, and practical demonstration of some functions of these systems. (3 Theory hrs. Lecture. 1 hr. Laboratory.)
